

PROCLAMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECEMBER 6, 2023, AS "MINERS HERITAGE DAY" THROUGHOUT COLFAX COUNTY

WHEREAS, IN 2023, CONGRESS PROCLAIMED DECEMBER 6TH AS NATIONAL MINERS DAY; AND
